Rubrics	<b>→</b>	<ul> <li>Include online rubrics for assignments that measure skills or performance. (Canvas assignments and discussions have the option to add a rubric)</li> </ul>		
Feedback	<b>→</b>	<ul> <li>Provide all students regular and timely feedback on activities and assignments.</li> <li>Use the Canvas gradebook to keep track of assignments and monitor student progress</li> <li>Provide mid-semester feedback.</li> <li>Provide students with informal 1-1 feedback through email. This is most important for struggling students.</li> <li>Online students need regular feedback or check-in to keep them accountable.</li> </ul>
